

# Why do we need an anonymization tool?



www.qualiservice.org

- RDC Qualiservice
- specialized on archiving and sharing qualitative research data in the social & behavioral sciences
- importance of data protection and research ethics
- anonymization and pseudonymization central instruments





#### Why do we need an anonymization tool?

- researchers need to deal with two potentially conflicting interests: protecting personal data vs. enabling research or re-use
- special contextual density of qualitative data
- anonymization and pseudonymization of qualitative data are comprehensive and time consuming

>> QualiAnon to support and facilitate the protection of sensitive information.

- allow for data protection and make research possible
- Anonymization is one part of the Qualiservice' concept of data protection
- "Flexible Anonymization" (Kretzer 2013)
  - Replace sensitive information with information relevant for social science research
  - Document the replacements on different abstraction levels and keep them thus reversible
- A detailed guide on the anonymization of qualiative text data will be published soon.





### Scenario 2: Tool-Application in the research project

- Researchers are confronted with questions of data security at different stages of their research process.
- Researcher need to provide anonymized data for different purpose.
- Need for flexible procedures.
- Qualiservice cooperates with researches, offers support, and checks the anonymization of a dataset. Data preparation is done in the research project.





#### Objectives of the tool development:

- QualiAnon should mark and replace sensitive information on different abstraction levels.
- It should document the replacements and allow for adaptations.
- It should allow for the integration of standardized lists (e.g., ISCO)
- It should allow to replace information on case basis as well as on study level.
- The export of versions differing in the amount of sensitivity should be possible.
- The user should be in control.
- The tool should be sustainable developed.






#### **Ensuring sustainability**

- QualiAnon is developed as an Open Source Tool.
- Software, manual an code will be accessible via GitHub (we will talk about this later again)
- GitHub allows for feedback and further development.
- There are no fees related to the use of QualiAnon







# Goal No.1 Anonymization






- Additional conditions
  - Counting and labels must be consistent over all interviews of a project
  - Creation of different anonymizations must be fast and easy






